One hundred and seventy-three volunteers were excluded from the study because they were unable to walk; had sought treatment for pain in the hip or knee in the past; had a known disease of the spine; had an operation on the spine, hip, or knee; or had had a previous injury or abnormal condition of the lower extremities (other than".
